FOWNHOPE COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD - CRITERIA

- Eligible - anybody resident now or in recent past or working within the Parish
- Nomination – in writing by any person or groups – normally resident or with close association with Fownhope
- Once a nomination has been made, they will be considered for award in following three years ie no need to make repeat nominations each year

The nominee must have

- ❖ Provided service meeting needs of people in Fownhope
- ❖ And be considered to be held in esteem/ respect within the community
- ❖ Can be for arts, leisure, youth, business, education, environment, health, social care etc

Shown one or more of these qualities -

- ✓ Made a real difference to the quality of life and vitality of our community
- ✓ helped to enhance the reputation of Fownhope
- ✓ Shown innovation and entrepreneurship
- ✓ Shown organisational or leadership skills
- ✓ Held in respect within the local community
- ✓ Improved life for those less able to help themselves
- ✓ Shown vision in delivering a service
- ✓ Overcome personal obstacles

Citation should ideally list the local organisations, roles and timescale which the awardee has been involved with.

Unlikely to make an award to somebody who has been involved for less than three years but a long length of service will not in itself necessarily merit an award

Award can be made to services provided in a professional or business capacity (*ie for profit rather than as volunteer*) but in such cases awards will only be made where that service not only meets above criteria, but is considered to be particularly exceptional
